*"World Camp for Jesus:
Declaring God's Glory to the
Nations"*

The **World Camp for Jesus 2017** was held at the International Convention Center Jerusalem (ICCJ) from August 2-3, 2017. This event was in response to the Lord's leading to celebrate the 50th Anniversary of Jerusalem's Freedom and Victory and

Israel's 70th Anniversary.

The Camp was a gathering of the Body of Christ from all nations, from all walks of life: leaders and members, the young and the mature in faith; denominational and non-denominational churches/congregations/ ministries/organizations; worshippers (singers/dancers); shofar blowers; worship flaggers; intercessors; and prayer warriors for unified global celebration, worship, prayer, and intercession (Psalm 133; Psalm 150:1-6; Psalm 122:6).

The Camp allowed people to meet with leaders of various ministries, to share stories of God's working in lives, and to spur one another to love and good works. The Holy Spirit moved powerfully as His Presence hovered and permeated.

A highlight for me personally was the opportunity to meet and speak with Karen Davis. Karen Davis is the worship leader of Kehalit HaCarmel (Carmel Assembly), a Messianic Assembly built in Mount Carmel, Haifa, Israel. Their ministry is a front line worship warfare ministry, and Karen spoke on "The Warrior Bride" during the Camp along with leading worship. In my humble opinion, Karen Davis' music, which she writes, is the most anointed music available for front line strategic spiritual warfare, and we use it almost exclusively. We had lunch with Karen Davis, a beautiful and timely surprise. Karen and I found many commonalities. Both Karen and I recently had our husbands die from cancer and shared some details of what we both called at the same time “an ordeal.” We both ministered in spite of our personal grief, in obedience to the LORD’s call. Her music background in Jazz paralleled my husband Jim’s background in Jazz. While we do not share the same specific call, we do share front line strategic spiritual warfare calls, hers mostly specific to Israel and mine to the nations wherever I am sent.

As MCM has had 8 calls to Jerusalem/Israel, we have experienced God’s heart for Israel. My first message was changed by the LORD the night before I was to give it. We must always follow the leading of the Holy Spirit because He is in both the process of getting us where we need to be in our mind and in the results. So I had had something prepared for “Declaring God’s Glory among the Nations.” Then the Holy Spirit kept going over and over a message in my mind, all night until one hour before I had to get up to get ready for the Camp Meeting, I finally got up and wrote it all down. It was the Gospel, for the work of Christ in redemption is the declaration of God’s Glory which goes out to all the nations, from Jerusalem to Judea to Samaria

to the uttermost parts of the earth. (Acts 1:8) Jesus is the Glorious One. Beginning with the wondrous work of the Living God in Creation and Redemption through Jesus Christ set the Camp on a sure foundation.

December 30, 2016 Craighouse

Friday, January 20, 2017
